

WHAT ARE THE CAFE STANDARDS?

CAFE, or Corporate Average Fuel Economy, are Standards set to make your car or truck more fuel efficient, increasing miles per gallon, reducing overall fuel cost and reducing emissions.



A QUICK HISTORY OF CAFE



- 1 Congress orders NHTSA to regulate fuel economy in response to Arab Oil Embargo
- 2 CAFE standards ramp up from 18 to 27.5 MPG by 1985
- 3 Congress orders greater fuel economy with Energy Independence and Security Act
- A CAFE standards raised to 34.1 MGH by 2016
- CAFE standards raised to 54.5 MPG by 2025
- 6 CAFE goals subject to midterm review
